Here are brief explanations of these words' meanings and parts of speech. You can find out even more about these words — including additional definitions — in your own dictionary!

dusty (*duh-sti*)

1. **adjective** Covered in dust.

golf (*golf*)

1. **noun** A game in which players use clubs to hit a small white ball around a special course and into a hole.
2. **verb** To play the game of golf.

healthy (*hel-thee*)

1. **adjective** If you are healthy, you are fit and well.
2. **adjective** Something that is healthy makes you fit, as in *a healthy diet*.

helpful (*help-ful*)

1. **adjective** Someone or something helpful offers aid or makes it easier to do something.

midnight (*mid-nite*)

1. **noun** Twelve o'clock in the middle of the night.

milkshake (*milk-shayk*)

1. **noun** A dessert drink made of ice cream and milk.

nicely (*nisse-lee*)

1. **adverb** Pleasantly, politely.

perspiration (*purs-puhr-a-shun*)

1. **noun** Sweat. *After he ran a mile, his face was wet with perspiration.*

radiant (*ray-dee-uhnt*)

1. **adjective** Bright and shining.

scary (*skair-ee*)

1. **adjective** Frightening, spooky.

selfish (*sel-fish*)

1. **adjective** Someone who is selfish puts his or her own feelings and needs first and does not think of others.

soar (*sor*)

1. **verb** To fly very high in the air.
2. **verb** To rise or increase very quickly.

spinnerets (*spin-ner-etts*)

1. **noun** Parts of spiders' bodies used to spin silky thread for their webs or cocoons.

star (*star*)

1. **noun** A ball of burning gases in space. A star is seen from the earth as a tiny point of light in the night sky.
2. **noun** A shape with five or more points.
3. **noun** A person who plays a leading role in a movie, play, or TV program.
4. **verb** To take the leading role in a movie, play, or TV program.

super (*soo-pur*)

1. **adjective** Very good; excellent.

tasty (*tayst-ee*)

1. **adjective** Flavorful, yummy.

ugly (*uhg-lee*)

1. **adjective** Unattractive.

voice (*voiss*)

1. **noun** The power to speak and sing. *Lois has lost her voice.*

2. **noun** The sound produced when you speak or sing. *Martha has a high voice.*

3. **verb** When you voice an opinion, you express it.

weak (*week*)

1. **adjective** Having little strength, force, or power.

well (*wel*)

1. **adverb** If you do something well, you do it in a good, skillful, thorough, or satisfactory way.

2. **adjective** Healthy.

3. **noun** A deep hole from which you can draw water, oil, or natural gas from the ground.
