

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. Every entry MUST have the following information: student name, teacher name, age/grade, school name, address, and telephone. All entries must be received by April 28, 2008. Winners will be notified by May 16, 2008. All entries, including rights therein of winning entries, become the property of Scholastic Inc. and will not be returned.
