How Does Each Leveling System Work?

Grade Level Equivalent (RL)

Reading level is determined by the result of one or more standard readability formulas that assess, among other things, the number of sentences per page, length and complexity of sentences, and vocabulary. Reading level also factors in expert teachers' evaluations of each book's curriculum and developmental appropriateness.

Developmental Reading Assessment (DRA)TM

These levels indicate a student's independent reading level. This system also tracks the students' oral reading, fluency, and comprehension.

Guided Reading Levels (GRL)

This system, developed by Drs. Irene Fountas and Gay Su Pinnell, evaluates a variety of factors—book and print features, text structures, themes and ideas, vocabulary, language and literary features—to provide instructional levels for books from A to Z, grades K-6.

The LEXILE[®] Framework[®] for Reading Levels (LEXILE[®])

This system measures semantic and syntactic difficulty of text, as well as assesses an independent reader's comprehension of text. LEXILE[®] is a registered trademark of MetaMetrics, Inc.

Accelerated Reader[®] (AR)

This leveling system works in conjunction with the Accelerated Reader quiz disk program and is based upon the ATOS Readability Formula. The formula determines the reading level of a book based on word length, frequency, sentence length and book length. Based on the level of the book, students will receive a certain number of Accelerated Reader Points upon completion of the corresponding quiz.
