Making Research Papers Simple!

Help your child organize his or her next research project with colored index cards. Here's how!

- 1. Sit down with your child and write the following at the top of five different colored index cards:
 - INTRODUCTION
 - QUESTION 1
 - QUESTION 2
 - QUESTION 3
 - CONCLUSION
- Select one card each day and challenge your child to find information that relates to that specific card. Write down the facts and the source on the card.
- 3. Over time, find three to four facts about each topic. Remind your child to be consistent—if he or she runs out of room on the green index card about the introduction, an additional green index card can be used.
- 4. Once your child has collected three or four cards worth of information for each topic, the writing process can begin.



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
