Title I, Part C—Education of Migratory Children

OVERVIEW

Goal is to support high-quality and comprehensive educational programs for migrant children to help reduce the educational disruptions and other problems that result from repeated moves.

Formula funds based on each state's per-pupil expenditure and counts of migrant children between 3 and 21 years old

USE OF FUNDS

- Instructional services such as educational activities for preschool-age children and instruction in elementary and secondary schools, such as tutoring before and after school
- Support services or educationally related activities, such as advocacy for migrant children; health, nutrition, and social services for migrant families; necessary educational supplies; transportation
- SEAs may use the following methods for delivering Migratory services:
 - ▷ Extended day programs
 - ▷ Before/after school programs
 - ▷ In-class programs
 - ▷ Saturday or vacation programs
 - ▷ In-home instruction
 - ▷ Summer intersession programs
 - ▷ Distance learning programs
 - ▷ Title I Schoolwide programs

KEY POINTS

- **Holds migrant children to the same challenging state content and student performance standards as all children.**
- **In a Title I, Schoolwide program, a school may combine MEP funds with funds from other Federal, State, and local programs to serve all of its students, regardless of their eligibility for the program.**
