### **Title V, Part A—Innovative Programs**

#### **OVERVIEW**

Goal is to support state and local efforts to implement promising education reform programs and provide a continuing source of innovation and educational improvement. Also help meet the education needs of at-risk and high-need students and support programs to improve school, student, and teacher performance.

Formula funds based upon the percentage of Economically Disadvantaged students.

#### **USE OF FUNDS**

- Implementing promising educational reform programs and school improvement programs based on scientifically based research.
- Activities that provide a continuing source of innovation and educational improvement to meet educational needs of all students, including at-risk youths.
- Support programs that provide library services and instructional and media material to students.
- Develop and implement education programs to improve school, student, and teacher performance.

#### **KEY POINTS**

- **Funding can be used in a broad range of areas to improve academic achievement and the quality of education for students, to improve teacher quality, and to improve school performance.**
- **Due to the wide range of activities allowable under this program, this is a good source of funding for all Scholastic materials.**
