

Workshop 2: Tsunami: Disaster of the Century**Quick Project**
Be Prepared!

If the weather turns deadly, what will you do?

Project: Create an emergency plan for your family in case of disaster.

Procedure

1. Brainstorm ideas. Ask yourself these questions:

- What is the safest place to go until the danger passes?
- How will family members keep in touch?
- What supplies should each person have packed and ready?

2. Make two lists. What should you do? List the steps in your family emergency plan.

- Decide on a meeting place where everyone should gather.
- Explain how everyone will keep in touch.

What should you bring? List the items you should have ready in a bag or backpack in case of emergency. Here are some ideas:

- Survival items: food, water, medicine, money
- Personal items: a journal, a family photograph

Also, list emergency phone numbers and all family phone numbers.
Add your own ideas.

3. Go over the plan. Discuss the plan at home. Ask family members for their suggestions.

4. Present your plan. Compare your plan with other students' emergency plans. What do they have in common? What is different about them? Explain your choices.
