What is South Africa like today?

Project: Create a brochure that encourages people to travel to South Africa.

Procedure

- 1. Generate ideas.** List ideas of types of places that you want to include in your travel brochure. Here are some ideas to get you started:
 - cities and towns to visit
 - historical sites
 - national parks
 - safarisWrite a few ideas of your own.
- 2. Research ideas.** Go to the library or use the Internet to get information.
 - Use these search terms to find information on the Internet: “South Africa” and “tourism”
 - Check an encyclopedia or nonfiction book about South Africa.
- 3. Take notes.** Choose at least three different tourist sites. Write three details that describe each site, such as location, what visitors might see, and what they might do.
- 4. Plan a layout and write a draft.** Create your brochure by folding a piece of paper in thirds. Add a title and message to the cover. Inside, set up headings for each tourist site. List facts under each heading.
- 5. Present your work.** Write a final draft on a clean sheet of folded paper. Add pictures or illustrations. Share your brochure with your class.
