Project: Create a poster about Nelson Mandela.

Procedure**1. List ideas.**

Brainstorm questions about Nelson Mandela. Here are some ideas to get you started:

- What did Nelson Mandela do before he became president of South Africa?
- What important changes did he help bring to South Africa?

Write a few ideas of your own.

2. Conduct research.

Go to the library or use the Internet to gather information.

- Use these search terms to find information on the Internet: “Nelson Mandela” and “biography”
- Check an encyclopedia or nonfiction book about Nelson Mandela.

3. Take notes.

Write facts that answer your questions about Nelson Mandela. Take notes on any other interesting facts that you learn. Find a quotation from Mandela. If possible, print pictures that you can use on your poster.

4. Make your poster.

Choose at least three facts to include on your poster. Use bold colors to make your words stand out. Write your words in a large size so they can be seen. Include a quote and pictures or illustrations. Display your poster in the classroom or hallway.
