- 1. Brainstorm ideas.** Think of questions about how science helps fight crime. For example, you might want to know:
 - What types of evidence help forensic scientists solve a crime?
 - What tools do forensic scientists use to examine evidence?

Feel free to use other ideas that come to mind.

- 2. Research.** To conduct your research:
 - Take notes on the facts you learned from the Workshop and the Anchor DVD.
 - Go to the library to find books about forensic science.

Write facts that answer your questions and other interesting information you find.

- 3. Write a draft.** Create an outline of your news article. For example:
 - A. Introduction
 - B. Evidence that forensic scientists look for
 - C. Tools that forensic scientists use
 - D. Conclusion

Write a draft of your article on paper.

- 4. Present your work.** Write or type a final draft of your story on a clean sheet of paper. Exchange your newspaper article with other members of a small group.
