Procedure**1. Generate questions.**

With a partner, choose the career you would like to research: pathologist, toxicologist, or forensic biologist. List questions about this career. For example:

- What kind of schooling do you need?
- What skills do you need?
- What are the responsibilities of the job?

Add as many questions as you like.

2. Research.

Start by reading about your career on page 90 of your *rBook Flex*. You may also use the Internet or library books to find information. If you need help figuring out which web sites are the best ones to use, ask a librarian or a teacher.

3. Take notes.

With your partner, look for answers to your questions. Also take notes on other interesting facts. For each fact, make sure you write down your source, whether it's a web site or a book.

4. Present your work.

List your facts in a bulleted list on a piece of paper. Include an illustration or photo, if possible. Share your findings with others.
