**Jack London Poster**

*Jack London's life was as adventurous as the stories he wrote!*

**Project:** Work with a partner to design a Jack London poster.

**Procedure****1. List ideas.**

Brainstorm questions about Jack London with your partner. Here are some ideas to get you started:

- What was Jack London's childhood like?
- What inspired his stories of adventure?

Write a few ideas of your own.

**2. Research ideas.**

Go to the library or use the Internet to gather information.

- Use these search terms to find information on the Internet:  
"Jack London" and "biography"
- Check an encyclopedia or nonfiction book about Jack London.

**3. Take notes.**

Write facts that answer your questions about Jack London. Take notes on any other interesting facts that you learn. Find a quotation from London or one of his stories. If possible, print pictures and book covers for your poster.

**4. Make your poster.**

With your partner, choose three facts to include on your poster. Use bold colors to make your words stand out. Write your words in a large size so they can be seen. Remember to include a quotation and pictures or illustrations. Display your poster in the classroom or hallway.
