

Workshop 8: Going Global**Extended Project****Global Countries Fact Sheet**

Take a closer look at the effects of globalization.

Project: Find out more about the effects of globalization on one country. Create a fact sheet presenting your findings.

Procedure

- 1. Generate ideas.** Choose either China or India. Brainstorm questions about ways that globalization has changed everyday life in that country. Think about specific areas of daily life. For example:
 - **Food** How has globalization affected what people eat in China/India? Have big supermarkets changed what farmers grow there?
 - **Education** Do students in China/India have access to the Internet? How has this affected their ability to get an education?Write more questions of your own.
- 2. Research ideas.** Use the Internet to find up-to-date information.
 - Try general search terms to get started: “China” or “India” and “globalization”
 - Choose a topic that interests you, such as sports, transportation, or fashion. Type “China” or “India” and your topic.
- 3. Take notes.** Look for information about the ways globalization has affected your topic. Write down key facts. If possible, download pictures from the web sites you visit.
- 4. Create your fact sheet.** Write an informative title for your fact sheet. List three to five facts that you think people should know about your topic. Draw attention to each fact with a colored dot or symbol. If you add a photo or illustration, write a brief caption to go with it.
