

Workshop 4: Bullies Beware**Quick Project****Advice to the Bullied**

Being bullied is no fun at any age.

Project: Make a poster about bullying for the first graders in your school.

Procedure**1. Brainstorm ideas.**

Write your answers to the following questions:

- What do you wish you had known about bullies in first grade?
- How would this information have helped you?
- What is the most important advice you can give first graders about being bullied? State this as a simple, clear message on your poster.
For example: *Just walk away from a bully!*

2. Plan your layout.

How will your poster look? Can you illustrate your advice? What kind of illustrations do you think first graders would like best?

3. Get feedback.

Ask a classmate or friend to look over your poster. Is your advice clearly written? Is your information simple enough for first graders? Make changes if needed.

4. Present your work.

See your teacher to set up a visit to the first-grade class. Display your poster where the class can see it. Spend five minutes talking to the students. Invite them to ask questions.
