Identity Collage

What qualities define YOUR identity?

Project: Use magazine photos, personal photos, and words to make an identity collage.

Procedure**1. Write down ideas.**

What makes up your identity? Use these questions to get you thinking:

- What do you look like?
- Where were you born?
- Who are your family members?
- What style of clothes do you wear?
- What kind of music do you listen to?
- What are your favorite sports or hobbies?

You can use some of these ideas, or come up with ideas of your own.

2. Collect pictures.

Look for magazine pictures you can use to tell about yourself. If possible, bring in personal photos that you can include.

3. Create your collage.

Arrange the pictures and glue them onto a poster board. Add words or phrases that tell about you. Create drawings if you'd like.

4. Present your work.

Share your collage with the class.

- Point out two or three of your favorite images or words that reflect your identity. Explain why you included them.
- Invite classmates to ask you questions about your collage.
