Missing Persons Poster

Louisa Tether is missing! Create a missing persons poster to help bring her home.

Project: Work with a partner. Create a missing persons poster about Louisa Tether from “Louisa, Please Come Home.”

Procedure**1. Identify key information.**

List important details for the poster. Use ideas from the story. Think about including:

- photos or drawings of Louisa.
- details that describe what she looks like, such as age, height, weight, eye color, and hair color.
- where she was last seen.
- what she was wearing.
- any other information that would help people identify her.
- what someone should do if they see her.

2. Plan your layout.

Sketch out some ideas for your poster. What information should be the largest? How will you grab people’s attention?

3. Locate or create images.

Draw your own picture of Louisa, or use a picture from a magazine.

4. Present your work.

Put it all together on a piece of poster board. Use markers, your best handwriting, and pictures to grab people’s attention. Display your poster in the classroom.
