Identity Poem*What's in a name?*

Project: Write a poem about your identity, using the first letter of your name to begin each line.

Procedure**1. Brainstorm ideas.**

Think about what you will include in the poem, such as:

- details about your personality.
- what you look like.
- goals you have.
- things that are important to you.

Add other ideas of your own. Be creative!

2. Write your name. Then start your poem.

Write your name down the left side of a sheet of paper. Then begin each line of your poem with a letter of your name. For example:

- Always running late
- Not a morning person
- Naturally curly hair
- An anytime you need a friend, I'm here

3. Present your poem.

Write the final draft of your poem on a sheet of paper. Add pictures or decorations if you'd like. Display your poem in the classroom.
