Project: Create a fact sheet about Edward Jenner.

Procedure**1. Research Edward Jenner.**

Use the Internet or library resources to research information about Edward Jenner.

- Try these search terms on an Internet browser: “Edward Jenner,” “Jenner and smallpox.”
- Visit The Jenner Museum at www.jennermuseum.com.
- Check an encyclopedia or nonfiction biography.

2. Take notes.

Write down at least five important facts about Edward Jenner. You might include:

- when and where he was born.
- where he went to school.
- how he discovered the smallpox vaccine.
- how the vaccine has made a difference.

Come up with additional ideas of your own.

3. Write a draft.

Organize your ideas on paper. Present your facts in the sequence in which they occurred.

4. Present your work.

Type your work on the computer. Use a boldface type for the title and other headings. Use a font that is a good size for people to read. You may want to add illustrations and photos from your research.
