

**Workshop 3: Combat Zone****Reading 2 Project: The Names**  
**Poetry Display**

*“The Names” pays tribute to the victims of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attack.*

**Project:** Make your own tribute. Create a display of a stanza from “The Names.”

**Procedure****1. Pick a stanza.**

Reread the poem on pages 66–69 of your *rBook*. Think about which stanza of the poem you like best. Which has the most interesting images and ideas? Pick a stanza of the poem to illustrate.

**2. Write it.**

Copy the stanza on poster board. Use your best handwriting. Use markers to make the words stand out.

**3. Illustrate it.**

How can pictures help show the meaning of the stanza? How can pictures help pay tribute to the victims? Draw illustrations on the poster board to go with the stanza. Or look for pictures from magazines that you can use.

**4. Present it.**

Display the stanza in the classroom along with other students’ stanzas. Organize the stanzas in the order in which they appear in the poem.
