

**Workshop 6: Amigo Brothers****Extended Project****The Competition Is On!**

*Competition is very powerful. It can have both positive and negative effects on people.*

**Project:** Create a display about competition. Include your definition of competition. Give information about three pairs of competitors.

**Procedure****1. Create a definition.**

Write down the answers to the following questions:

- What is your experience of competition?
- How do you feel about competition?
- What are some words that describe competition?

Edit your notes into a short definition about what competition is, and what it means to you.

**2. Pick three pairs of competitors.**

Choose competitors from your *READ 180* materials, such as Felix and Antonio in “Amigo Brothers,” and Vitali and Wladimir in the Anchor Video story. You can also choose well-known sports competitors, like Michael Phelps and Ian Thorpe, or political candidates.

**3. Expand ideas.**

Answer the following questions about each pair of competitors. Use the Internet or the library to find answers if needed.

- What do they want?
- How do they try to get it?
- What is the outcome of the competition?

If you find photos of your competitors, cut or print them out and attach them.

**4. Put it all together.**

Write your definition across the top of a piece of posterboard or chart paper. Then set up areas for each of your competitors. Attach pictures and add your facts. Don't forget a title!
