

Workshop 2: Coming to America**Quick Project**
Welcome Card

A new immigrant family is moving in nearby. How can you welcome the family?

Project: Create a welcome card for a new immigrant family.

Procedure**1. Use your imagination.**

Imagine that a family has just immigrated to America and moved to your neighborhood. What would help them feel at home?

2. Decide what to write in the card.

Ask yourself these questions to get started:

- What do people do for fun here? What places and events should the family know about?
- How will they find their way around? Will they need a map?
- Where is the school?
- Where are the best places to eat?

3. Create your card.

Fold a piece of paper in thirds. This will give you six sections to work with. Use the front section to welcome the family. Use the other sections to give them useful information. One section might be for a map. Another section might be for the names of restaurants.

4. Present your work.

Make your card as colorful and fun as possible. Give your card to a classmate. Compare the information you each included.
