

Workshop 4: Bullies Beware**Extended Project**
Bullying Awareness

Bullying is a serious—and dangerous—problem.

Project: Create a flier that gives facts about bullying and how to stop it. Put your flier together with others to create a Bullying Awareness display.

Procedure**1. Brainstorm ideas.**

Make a list of topics for your flier. Use information from pages 86–95 of your *rBook*. Here are some ideas to get you started.

- Define *bully*. Identify three kinds of bullies.
- Suggest three things the victim of a bully can do.

You may also use ideas of your own. Keep ideas short and focused.

2. Draft.

Choose your best idea to focus on. Write a short statement or explanation about your topic. You'll need to try a few rough drafts before you get the final design.

3. Design it.

Think about how to present your work so that others will notice it. Use color, large type, or other ideas.

Example: BULLYING: Fight back by speaking up!

4. Present your work.

Put the fliers from your class together in a display. Maybe you can set up the display in the cafeteria or the gym. That way, everyone can learn about bullying.
