

Workshop 5: Secrets of the Mummy's Tomb**Extended Project****Destination: Ancient Egypt**

Do you like mummies and pyramids? Then you'll love ancient Egypt!

Project: Work with a partner. Create a display about ancient Egypt.

Procedure

1. Choose a topic. With a partner, think about what interests you about ancient Egypt. Use these ideas to get started:

- Egyptian gods and goddesses
- the Egyptian system of writing, hieroglyphics
- the Nile River
- mummies
- pyramids

Or, you can choose an idea of your own.

2. Gather information. Use an encyclopedia or library books to get information. Find at least five facts about your topic. Also, answer these questions:

- Why is your topic important?
- What are some examples that tell more about the topic?
- What is the most interesting fact you learned?

3. Write. Write a short paragraph on your topic with your partner. Include the five facts that you found, and the answers to the questions in step 2.

4. Create your display.

If possible, draw or print out pictures and attach them to your paper. Share your paper with your classmates. Then display it in your class.
