

Workshop 6: Good Sports**Extended Project**
Playing Games

Can you teach someone else how to play your favorite game?

Project: What game or sport are you best at? Write instructions for a beginner who wants to play your game.

Procedure

1. List ideas. Choose the game or sport you will write instructions for. Then list answers for each of these questions.

- What is the goal or object of the game?
- How many players are needed?
- How does the game start?
- What does each player do?
- What are the most important rules?

Write notes for each question. Keep in mind that the rules are for beginners.

2. Review. Read your notes. Imagine that you've never played the game before. Do your notes make sense? Make any changes necessary.

3. Present your work. Type or neatly copy your instructions, using the format at the right. Add illustrations that will help the reader understand the game. Add a title for your instructions. Put them with others in a class book called *Instructions for Favorite Games*.
