**Buggy Menu**

**Project:** Work with a partner. Make a menu for a restaurant that serves bugs!

**Procedure****1. List bugs.**

Make a list of as many insects as you can think of (fleas, worms, ladybugs, mosquitoes).

**2. Brainstorm ideas.**

Think of foods that could be made with insects for breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

- What will you serve for breakfast? Maybe a cereal called Frosted Fleas?
- Will you serve Buggy Burgers for lunch?
- What about dinner? Cockroach Casserole?
- Don't forget desserts! You might include June Bug Pie or Slug Shakes!

**3. Draft.**

Sketch out ideas for how your menu will look. Think about how menus are organized. Most menus have prices. Some even have illustrations.

**4. Present your work.**

Write out your menu using your best handwriting. Think of a name for your restaurant. Add illustrations of some of the food items. Post your menu in the classroom.
