

Moving Data from Accelerated Reader® to Scholastic Reading Counts!® Enterprise Edition

If you are an Accelerated Reader user who has purchased **Scholastic Reading Counts!** Enterprise Edition, these instructions will assist you in ensuring that your entire Accelerated Reader student and quiz score data moves over to **Scholastic Reading Counts!** Enterprise Edition.

While you can transfer student data readily to **Scholastic Reading Counts!**, Accelerated Reader quizzes and teacher-made quizzes in Accelerate Reader do not transfer.

Step 1: Install Scholastic Reading Counts! v3.0.3 and import your Accelerated Reader data into the Scholastic Management Suite (SMS)

Prior to installing **Scholastic Reading Counts!** Enterprise Edition, you'll need to install **Scholastic Reading Counts!** v3.0.3. This product is included in your package. The standalone version install will suffice. Once you install, you'll need to import your Accelerated Reader database into the SMS. Follow the instructions that correspond to the version of Accelerated Reader you are using.

To import Accelerated Reader 4.0 data:

1. Launch the Management Suite (SMS).
2. Click EasyStart in the upper-left corner, then click Next until you reach the Import Data screen.
3. Click the "Import" button next to Accelerated Reader.
4. Navigate to the AR4 (Win or Mac) folder. Double-click it. Highlight the Data folder and click OK

To import Accelerated Reader 5.0 data:

1. Install SMS v1.3.2 updater onto workstation where the Management Suite is installed.
2. Launch the management suite (SMS).
3. Click EasyStart in the upper-left corner, then click Next until you reach the Import Data screen.
4. Click the <Import> button next to Accelerated Reader.
5. Navigate to the AccReader folder. Highlight the folder and click OK

To import Accelerated Reader 6.12 data:

1. Install SMS v2.0 with the Scholastic Management Suite
2. Launch the SMS
3. Click Easy Start, and move forward until you reach the data import screen.
4. Click on the Import button beside Accelerated Reader.
5. Navigate to the ALSDATA folder and click on OK (Windows) / SELECT (Macintosh)

Instructions on importing Accelerated Reader data into the Scholastic Management System can be found on pages 32-33 of the **Scholastic Reading Counts!** Software Manual.

Step 2: Install Scholastic Reading Counts! Enterprise Edition

You are now ready to install the **Scholastic Reading Counts!** Enterprise Edition. Follow the instructions on pages 15-52 in the Installation Guide, which was provided in this package.

Step 3: Download the Enterprise Edition data migration tools from the Scholastic Reading Counts! web site

Once you have both your student data and quizzes installed into the SMS, you will need to visit the **Scholastic Reading Counts!** website and download the tools required for Enterprise Edition data migration. They are located at:

Two tools will be downloaded – the SMS Data Prep Tool and the SMS Data Migration Tool. All information regarding migrating data from the SMS into SAM is documented in the Installation Guide, pages 74-87.

Step 4: Run the Data PrepTool to prepare your SMS data

This will prepare your data to easily install into SAM. Please follow the instructions on pages 75-79 of the Installation Guide.

Step 5: Install your SMS quizzes into SAM

During step 4, a .zip file was created containing all your quizzes from the SMS. You will need to install that into SAM prior to migrating your student data. Please follow the instructions on pages 80-83 of the Installation Guide. If you did not install any of your new **Scholastic Reading Counts!** quizzes into SMS, then you can simply install the quizzes into SAM (the management system of Enterprise Edition) prior to step 6.

Step 6: Migrate your student data into SAM

During step 5, a .smx file was created containing all your student data from the SMS. You will need to run the SMS Data Migration Tool to migrate that data into SAM. Please follow the instructions on pages 84-87 of the Installation Guide.
