In the book, *Preventing Reading Difficulties in Young Children*, the authors note that the key factors related to learning to read are alphabet knowledge, phonemic awareness, and being read to early and often. Children need to listen to the sounds of spoken language, use language in conversation, listen and respond to stories read aloud, connect sounds to letters, read often so the words become automatic, learn and use new words, and understand what was read. Research has shown that the more a child is read to, the more likely he or she is like to become a fluent reader. WESTON WOODS materials provide a convenient and natural way for children to engage in language exploration and book reading.

In the following chart, the books in the WESTON WOODS collection have been leveled using the Fountas and Pinnell guided reading levels. This allows the adult to choose a book which is appropriate for the individual child or that meets the needs of a group. In addition each WW title has also been correlated to address the skills identified as necessary to an effective reading program. Finally, each title has also been correlated to the Accelerated Reader® and SCHOLASTIC Reading Counts!® programs.

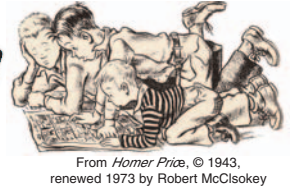

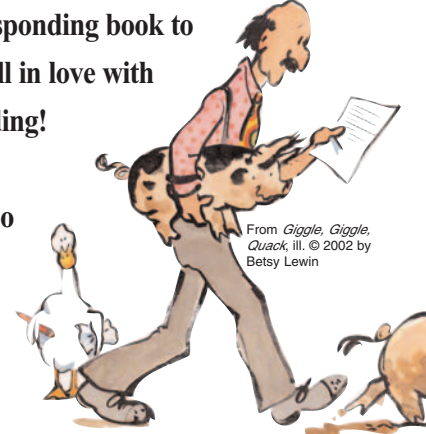

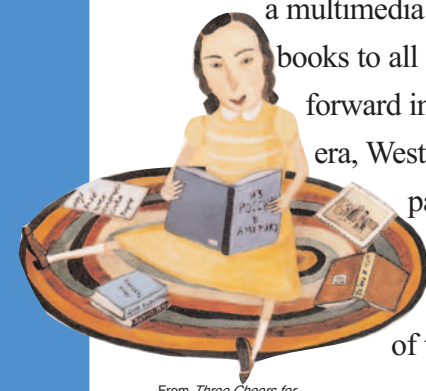
