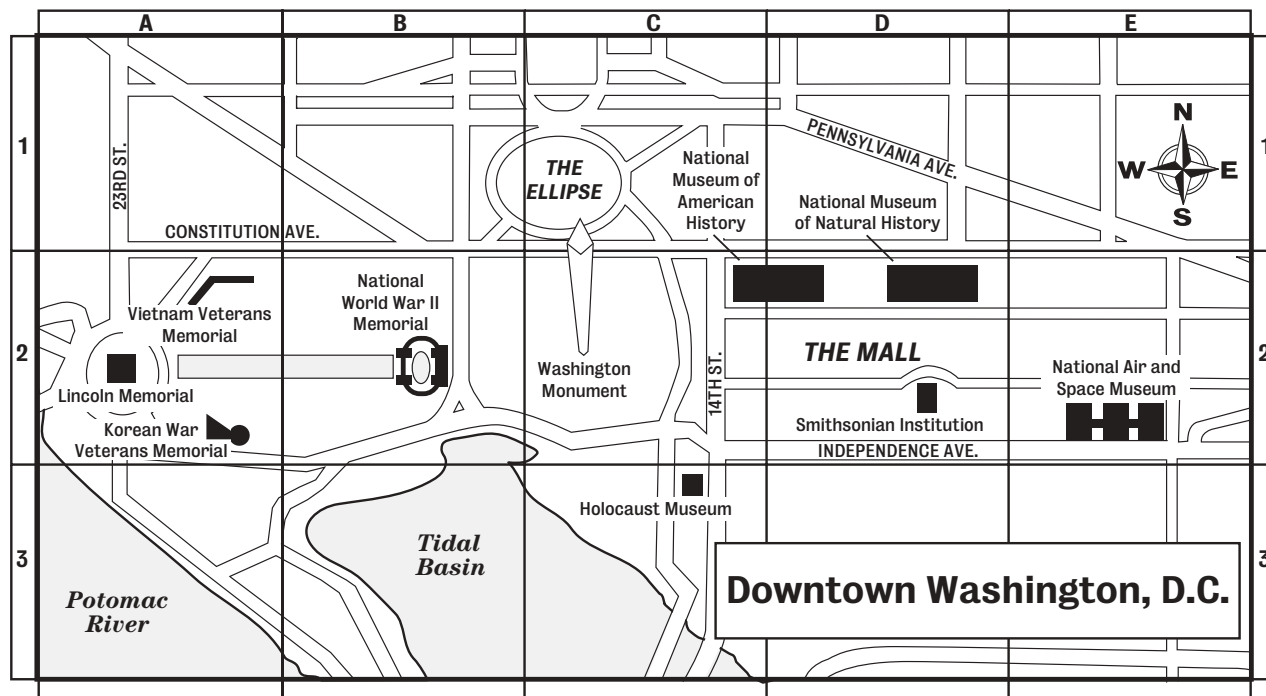

# Find It With a Grid

A grid map uses letters and numbers to find the location of a place. To use a grid map, put your finger on the letter across the top of the map. Then, put another finger on the number along the sides of the map. Slide your fingers together to find the square where the letter and number meet.
