### What to Do:

1. Read through the scenario below with your group.
2. Decide who will play the roles of the characters in the scenario.
3. Role play (act out) the scenario. Members of your group should decide what they think the best choice is.
4. What are the consequences of that choice for each character? Be ready to explain why you think the choice your group made is the best one.

You're doing math, watching students work problems on the board. The problems have not been difficult for you, but other students are having a harder time. When one person, who is sometimes not popular because he thinks he has all the answers, makes a simple mistake you...

**Choice A:** Laugh, point to the mistake, and try to make him feel stupid.

**Choice B:** Laugh to yourself but poke people around you so they will see the mistake.

**Choice C:** Say nothing, even when others notice.

**Choice D:** Raise your hand and offer a correction.
