### What to Do:

1. Read through the scenario below with your group.
2. Decide who will play the roles of the characters in the scenario.
3. Role play (act out) the scenario. Members of your group should decide what they think the best choice is.
4. What are the consequences of that choice for each character? Be ready to explain why you think the choice your group made is the best one.

During the weekend, a water pipe broke in school. The broken pipe was over the computer lab and library. On Monday morning, teachers and students faced a disaster: soaked books, ruined computers, and soggy carpets. Since the disaster was not only in the library, but in some classrooms as well, school has been called off.
