Tusk to Tusk

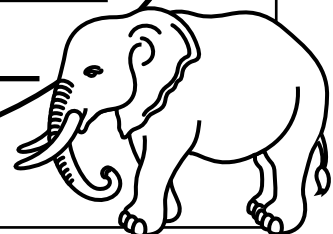
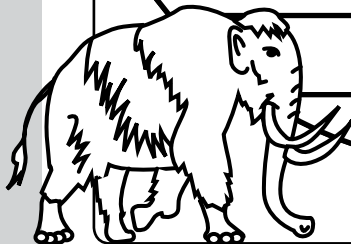
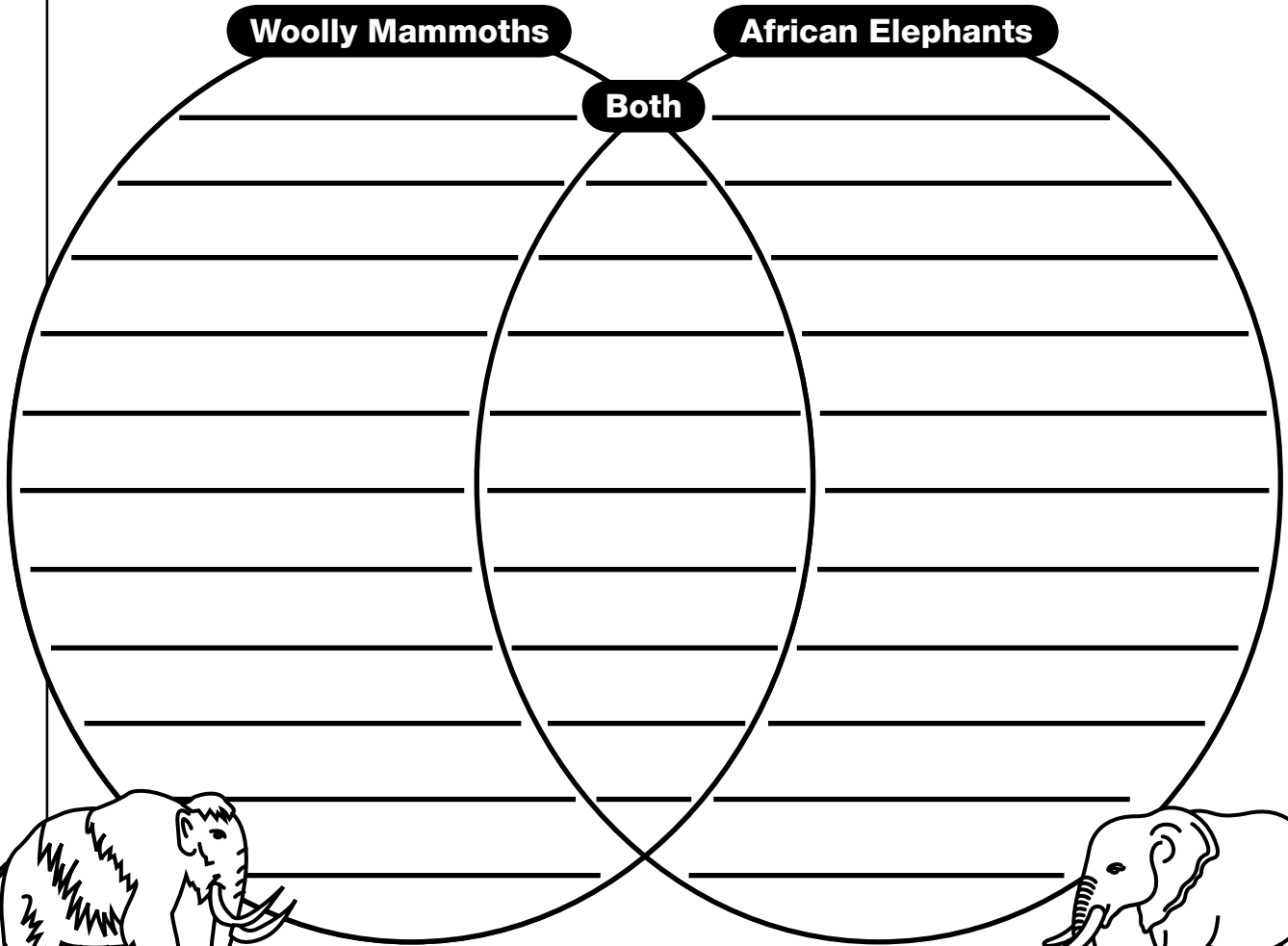
Woolly mammoths may remind you of another animal—the African elephant. Read the facts below to learn what these animals have in common and how they are different. Then, fill in the Venn diagram.
