## Genre List

- **Biography:**  
a true story about a person's life
- **Fiction:**  
a story about characters and events that are not real
- **Mystery:**  
a story about something that needs to be solved
- **Nonfiction:**  
a true story about, or description of, real things, people, or events
- **Poetry:**  
a book of writings that are set out in short lines, often with words that rhyme
- **Science Fiction:**  
a made-up story that includes future ideas, such as space travel and new technology.




