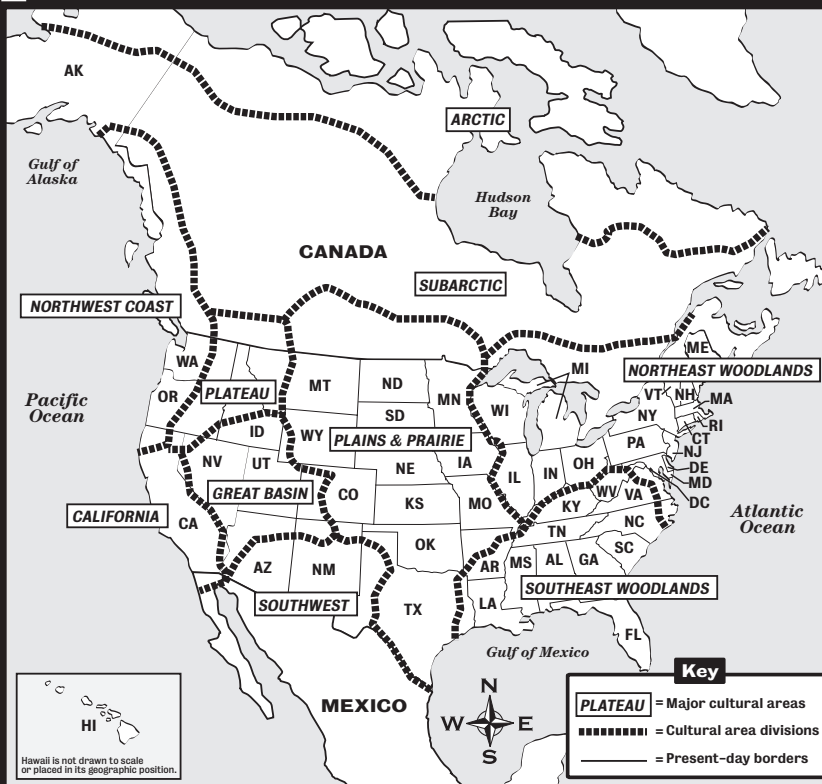

# Native North Americans

More than 560 American Indian groups, often known as tribes or nations, are recognized in the U.S. The map shows major North American cultural areas in which some of the most well-known American Indian and Alaska Native groups have lived. Groups living in the same cultural area often have similar customs, beliefs, and ways of life. Use the map to answer the questions.

## Major North American Cultural Areas of American Indians and Alaska Natives



<b>Northeast Woodlands</b> Iroquois (Mohawk, Onondaga, Cayuga, Oneida, Seneca, and Tuscarora), Potawatomi, Shawnee.
<b>Southeast Woodlands</b> The Cherokee, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Creek, Seminole.
<b>Plains &amp; Prairie</b> The Arapaho, Blackfoot, Cheyenne, Comanche, Kaw, Sioux.
<b>Southwest</b> The Apache, Navajo, Pima, Hopi.
<b>Great Basin</b> The Paiute, Shoshoni, Ute.
<b>California</b> The Klamath, Maidu, Miwok, Pomo, Yurok.
<b>Plateau</b> The Cayuse, Okanagan, Spokane, Walla Walla.
<b>Northwest Coast</b> The Chinook, Haida, Kwakiutl, Salish, Tlingit.
<b>Subarctic</b> The Beaver, Chipewyan, Cree, Ingalik, Montagnais, Tanana.
<b>Arctic</b> The Aleut, Inuit, Yipuk.
