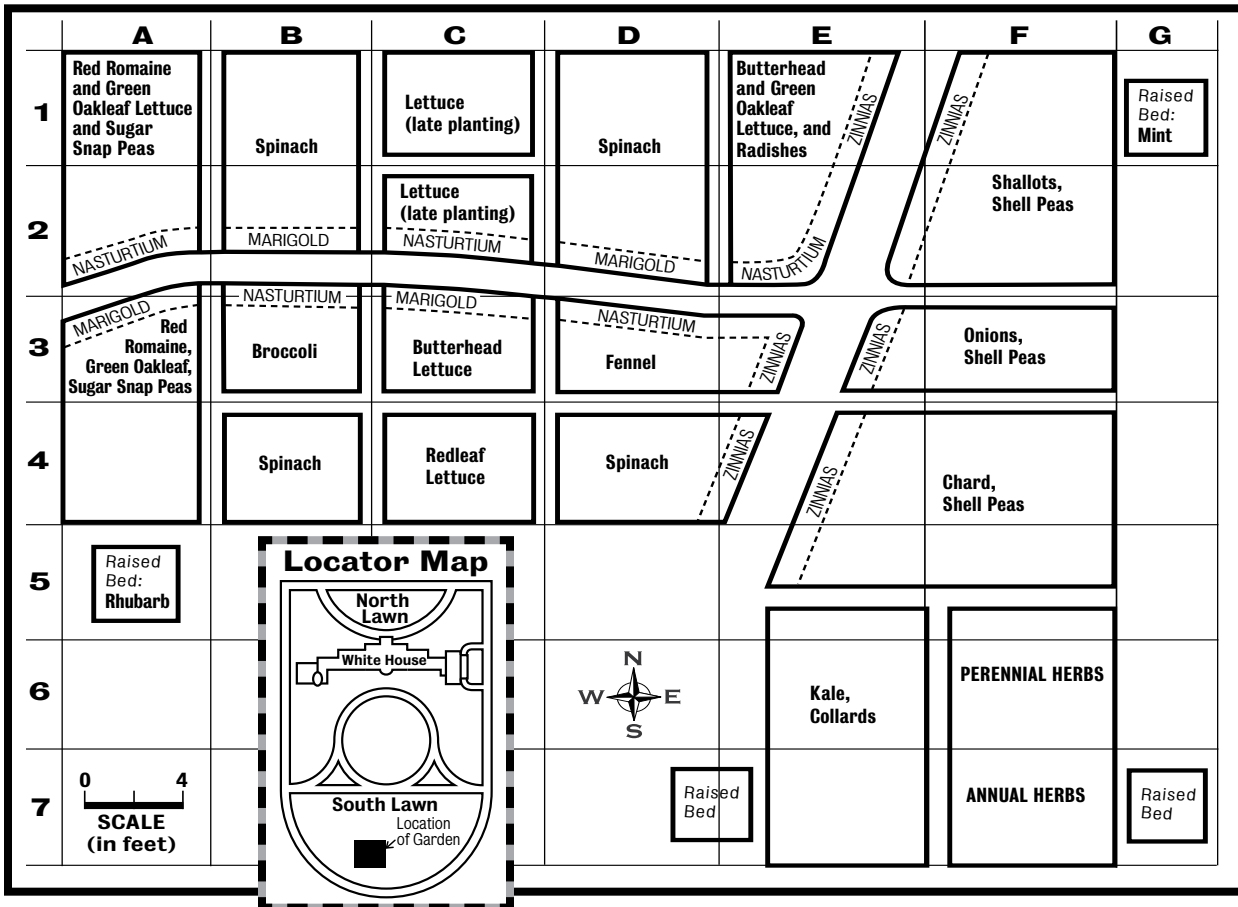

A Place to Grow

Now that you have read the *Scholastic News* story "Green Thumbs" on page 6, learn more about the types of plants that will be grown in First Lady Michelle Obama's new vegetable garden on the South Lawn of the White House.
