Headlines That Wow

A headline is the large text at the top of a story. A good headline tells you what the story is about, grabs your attention with clever wording, and makes you want to read the story.

EXAMPLE:

For a story about disappearing frogs, good headlines would be:

“Freaky Frog Mystery” or **“Sleuths in the Swamp”**

Some less exciting headlines would be:

“Frogs Disappear,” “Looking for Frogs,” or **“Frogs Big and Small”**
