	Unique images versus clichés: Do you use your own, fresh metaphors?	
	Powerful verbs: Are your verbs precise and descriptive?	
	Line breaks: Do you end lines with meaningful words?	
	Stanza breaks: Are you intentional about stanza break?	
	Meter/Sound: How does your poem sound when you read it aloud? Do the words flow together? Does your poem have a rhythm? Can you make small word changes to enhance alliteration or assonance?	
	Word choice: Can you justify every word in your poem?	
	Formatting: How does the poem look on the page?
