Babies Change and Grow!

These babies don't look much like their parents. But that will change as they grow up!

Emperor Penguin

A baby penguin is called a **chick**. Its head is black and white. Its body is covered in fluffy gray feathers called **down**. As the chick grows, its head turns black. It grows new feathers on its body—black for its back and white for its belly!





Silver Leaf Monkey

This baby monkey has bright orange fur. That helps the adults see it in the dark forest. As it grows older, the monkey's fur will change color. It will turn dark gray—just like its parents' fur.

Warty Newt

This is a newt. It lives in a pond. A newt starts out as an egg in the water. When it hatches, it becomes a **larva**. The larva breathes underwater with **gills**, just like a fish. But a newt's gills are on top of its head! When the larva turns into an adult, it lives on land.
