## Way to Bee Helpful!

What's for lunch, bee? Sweet nectar from a flower!

As a bee feeds, it also helps the flower make seeds.

Here's how!

- **1.** A honeybee visits a flower to drink its nectar. Later, the bee will use the nectar to make honey.
- 2. The bee also gathers tiny grains called pollen. It takes the pollen back to the hive for food. Some extra pollen sticks to the bee's body.
- **3.** The bee flies to a new flower.
- **4.** Some of the extra pollen rubs off the bee's body. The pollen sticks to the new flower.
  - 5. The pollen goes into the flower. It helps form seeds. A fruit grows around the seeds.

    Someday a hungry animal might eat the fruit. The seeds might drop to the ground and grow into new plants!
