
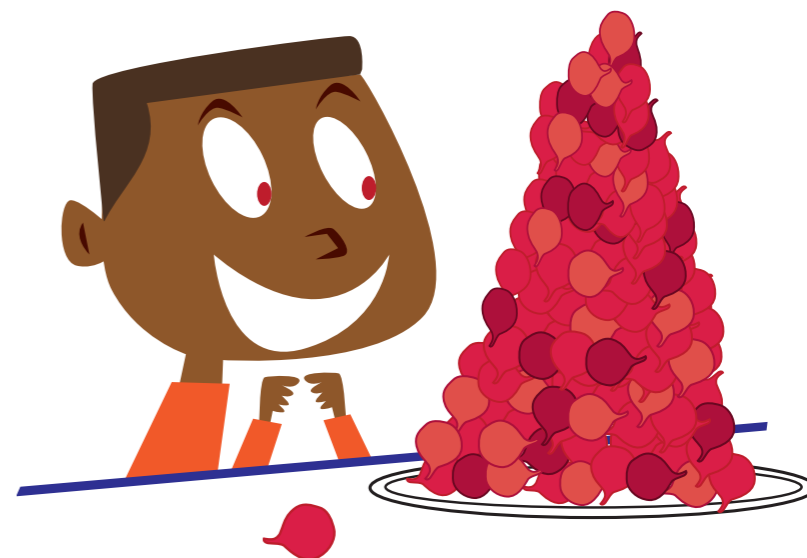


**41.** Jack's beanstalk was 118 feet high. The giant complained, so Jack cut off 65 feet. How tall is his beanstalk now?

A large grid consisting of 20 columns and 10 rows of squares, intended for drawing a bar model to solve the problem.

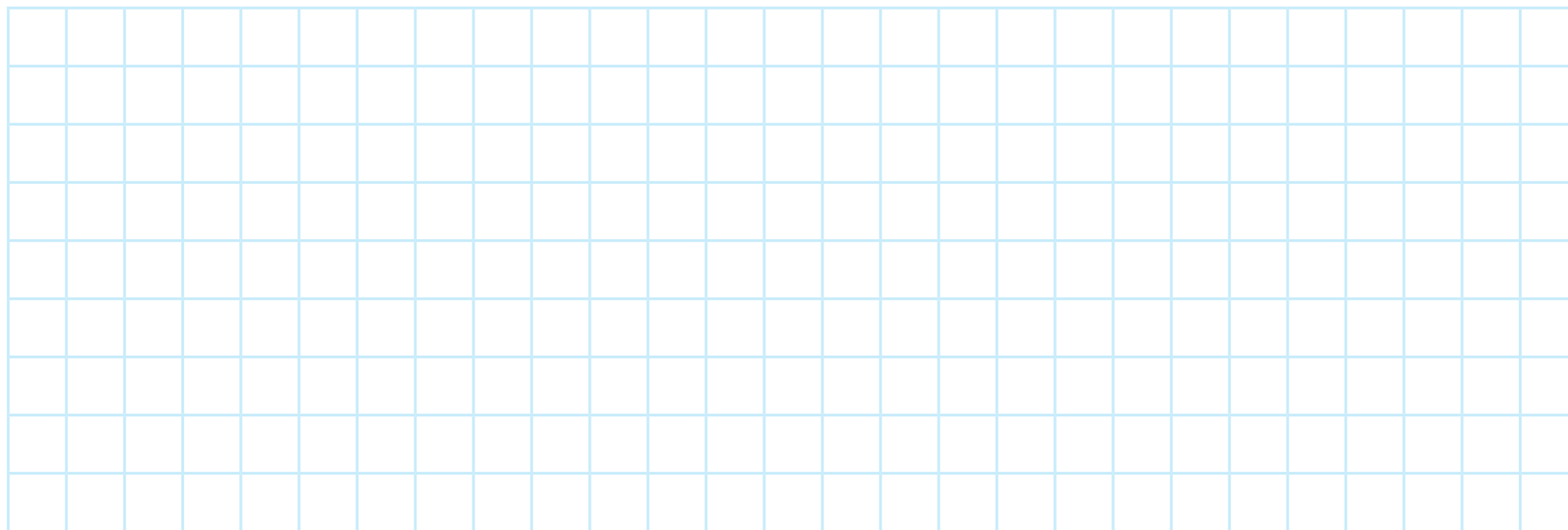

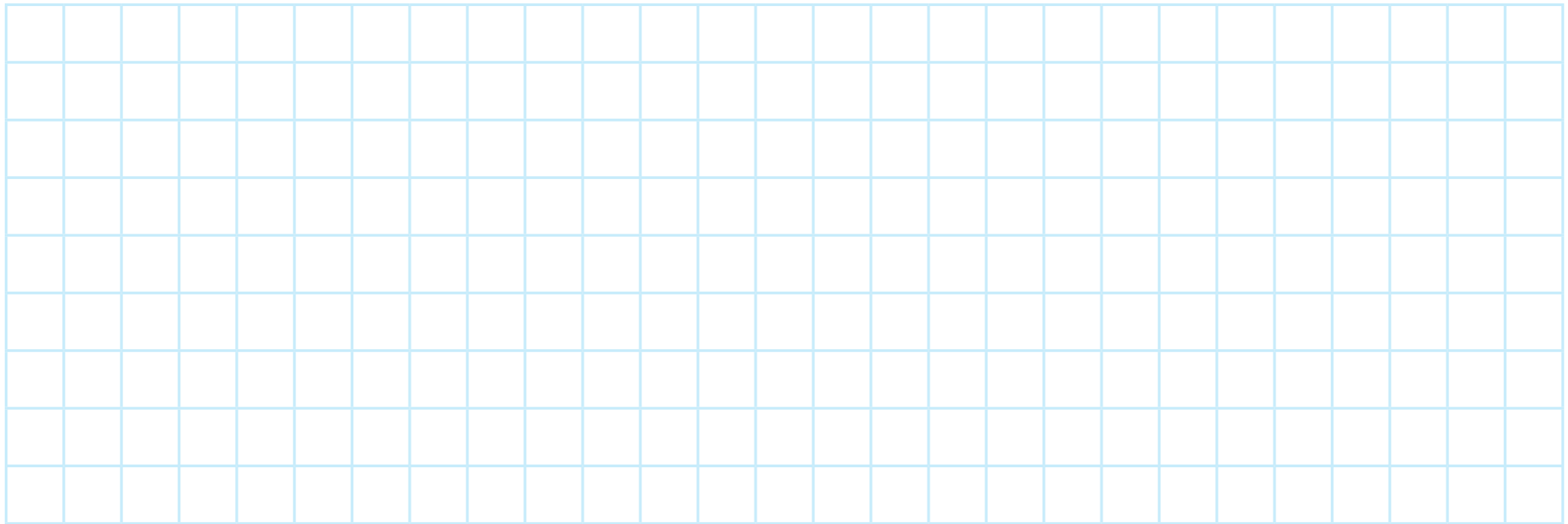
